Grading System for Basic Training and other courses

Overall grading on the basis of final percentage of marks (M) scored out of total marks in final examination has been awarded as per the following grading system -

If $90 \% \leq M$ = Grade 'A'	If $45 \% \leq M < 60 \%$ = Grade 'D'
If $75 \% \leq M < 90 \%$ = Grade 'B'	If $33 \% \leq M < 45 \%$ = Grade 'E'
If $60 \% \leq M < 75 \%$ = Grade 'C'	If $M < 33 \%$ = Grade 'F'

Explanation-1 In consequent to advisory issued on 27.12.2019, the result of the candidate may be declared as successful who attains overall minimum 75% attendance in theory and practical classes along with the awarded grading.

Explanation-2 However if the candidate(s) awarded **overall grading "F"**, the Institute will inform to the respective central govt./ States govt./UT's about the performance of the candidate in the training and further if respective Govt. think fit, may depute the candidate(s) in one month "Special Course for Manual Assistant" as a fresh to improve their skill as well as to upgrade the grading within two years from the date of publication of final result of their respective session.

Explanation-3 The candidate who has attended the theory and practical classes during the entire training course with overall minimum of 75% attendance, and could not appear in the Paper(s) of the final examination, may re-appear in any subsequent session of the above said course to complete the left over paper/papers of final examination within two years from the date of publication of final result of the respective session to award the grading.
